## OLYMPICS Milano – Cortina 2026

### Val di Fiemme (Predazzo and Tesero)

The ski jumping and cross-country skiing competitions will take place in Val di Fiemme during the Winter Olympics.

How to get there:

#### **1) By train:**

The transfer from the train to the shuttle buses takes place at Auer/Ora station. From there, the shuttles go directly to Predazzo and Tesero. The frequency of regional trains on the Brenner railway is increased in the morning and evening, with trains running every half hour between Bolzano and Trento. There are also additional trains and Regionale Veloce trains to and from Brenner/Brennero and Verona.

**Tickets:** All Tickets from [südtirolmobil](#) (including Südtirol Guest Pass) are valid.

#### **2) Park & Ride:**

There is a restricted traffic zone around the venues. Only authorized vehicles are permitted to drive through. Park & Ride facilities are available for a fee (€40.00) and must be **reserved in advance**. These can be booked at the following link: [Park & Ride](#). To make a reservation, each passenger must have a valid ticket for the event.

From there, the venues can be reached by a free shuttle service.

However, it is recommended to travel by public transport.

### LOCATION VIVAIO

The “Vivaio” car park in Masi will also be available during the Games. This car park is also subject to a fee (€ 40.00) and **requires a reservation**. The stadium can be reached on foot from there.

When registering, you must select a parking area. During the booking process, all available parking areas for the selected date and event will be displayed.

**Important:** Important notes regarding car park selection will be displayed during the booking process, especially if you have tickets for competitions in Tesero and Predazzo on the same day.

## 3) Shuttle-Service:

### 3.1) Special line

At **Auer/Ora** railway station, visitors can transfer to the Trentino Trasporti **shuttle service**, which takes them directly to “**Tesero Bus Terminal**” and “**Predazzo Bus Terminal**”. From there, the venues can be reached on foot. Usable only with a valid ticket.

### 3.2) Extension of bus line B101 during the Games

In addition, a public bus line operated by Trentino Trasporti (line B101) will transport guests from Ora to Tesero and Predazzo, with intermediate stops. These intermediate stops are:

- **Montan Dolomitenstraße/Montagna, Via delle Dolomiti**
- **Aldeiner Brücke/Ponte di Aldino**
- **Kaltenbrunn Abzweigung Truden/Fontanefredde, Bivio Trodena**
- **S. Lugano Kirche/San Lugano, Chiesa**

From Tesero (stop Tesero, Piazza Battisti), visitors attending the cross-country skiing competitions must change and take the Cross-Country Skiing Shuttle.

Visitors attending the ski jumping competitions continue on the same line and can get off in the area of the former brewery north of Predazzo. From there, the ski jumping stadium can be reached in approximately 10 minutes on foot.

Below is an excerpt from a resolution of the Provincial Government of Trento:

The shuttle service and public transport lines operated by Trentino Trasporti in the Fiemme and Fassa valleys are free of charge during the Games, provided you hold a valid ticket for a competition in the Fiemme Valley:


I servizi di linea di Trentino trasporti interessati sono i seguenti: servizio di trasporto extraurbano su gomma, comprese le linee dedicate per il trasporto spettatori che collegano le venue di gara con i parcheggi di interscambio presenti in Valle di Fiemme e con la stazione ferroviaria di Ora/Auer nonché i servizi della Ferrovia Trento-Malè-Marilleva.

Gli spettatori esibiranno al conducente/controllore un biglietto valido per una gara all'interno del cluster Val di Fiemme della giornata in cui viene effettuato lo spostamento (controllo a vista), che varrà come titolo di viaggio integrato Provincia di Trento.

## Bus timetables:

The extended B101 line operates hourly, departing from Auer/Ora always at :38 (for example 7:38, 8:38, etc.). The departure times for the subsequent stops are shown in the following chart.

### 3.3) Public bus line 140

During the Games, line 140 Auer/Ora – Cavalese will operate with its regular fares (free of charge with the Südtirol Guest Pass) and according to its standard timetable.

From the Cavalese bus station, passengers must change to line B101 to reach Tesero, Piazza Battisti (for the cross-country skiing competitions) and Predazzo (for the ski jumping competitions). From Tesero, Piazza Battisti, the free shuttle services will be operating.

With one or at most two transfers, it is possible to reach the destination in a relatively short time.

**Tickets** for line B101 Cavalese–Predazzo–Moena–Canazei–Penia and Penia–Canazei–Moena–Predazzo–Cavalese can be purchased online, at Trentino Trasporti ticket offices, or directly on board with cash. However, in accordance with a resolution of the Provincial Government, these lines are free of charge.
